- Demonstrated knowledge and experience producing materials explaining or analyzing complex US foreign assistance programs in areas of international conflict or tension to a variety of audiences and external stakeholders.
- Prior overseas work experience a plus, particularly with USAID (or other donors) and with international development.
- Ability to travel internationally for short-term consultancies.
- Strong written and oral communication skills.
- English fluency; proficiency in at least one language other than English preferred.
